Introduction: This program has been established to promote advanced technical studies for Collision Repair graduates. Because of the continuing growth of technology and the demands of the labor market, it is important that Collision Repair graduates acquire advanced educational credentials.

Administration: The Scholarship Selection Committee has the responsibility of administering the Scholarship Program. The Committee establishes application and selection guidelines. The Committee will review each application and determine the award recipients. All decisions of the Committee are final.

Process: Applications are now available in Student Services. Interested students should acquire an application and this explanation sheet. All application materials must be complete and submitted to the Committee by **3:00 PM on Friday, May 10, 2019**. Application materials include:

1. A completed Joseph P. Carpa Memorial Scholarship application form.
2. TEC Instructor letter of recommendation.
3. Letter of recommendation from a non-family individual who knows your character and potential.

Selection: Awards will be made by the Committee based on:

1. Technical education grades and achievement
2. Technical education program attendance record
3. School conduct or citizenship record
4. Clarity, quality and content of the personal summary on the application form
5. Evidence that the applicant is pursuing enrollment in a post-secondary education program
6. Letters of recommendation
7. Work experience

Eligibility: To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must, (1) be currently enrolled in the Collision Repair Program; (2) be in his/her final semester of high school and meet the requirements for TEC certification; and (3) the applicant must be making plans for enrollment in post-secondary collision repair education program.

Award Amount: For the 2019-2020 school year, the top applicant will receive a non-renewable \$750 award.

PLEASE NOTE: Award recipients must show proof of enrollment in an approved post-secondary education program before funds will be released.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: **3:00 PM – Friday, May 10, 2019.**
